Ar y 5ed dydd o Fehefin, 2024 gwnaed y Gorchymyn uchod gan Gyngor Gwynedd trwy ymarfer ei bwerau o dan y Ddeddf Rheoli Traffig y Ffyrdd 1984, fel y newidiwyd a phob pŵer galluogi arall ac ar ôl ymgynghori gyda Phrif Swyddog yr Heddlu yn unol â Rhan III o Atodlen 9 o Ddeddf Rheoli Trafnidiaeth Ffyrdd 1984.

Pan ddaw'r Gorchymyn i rym ar y 1af o Orffennaf, 2024 ei effaith fydd:-

- (a) Gwahardd pob cerbyd modur rhag mynd i mewn i'r rhan o ffordd a nodir isod neu fynd ymlaen ar hyd rhan o'r ffordd a nodir isod o 8.00 – 9.30 y bore a 2.30 – 4.00 y prynhawn ar ddydd Llun – dydd Gwener, ac eithrio mynediad i eiddo ar y ffordd honno ac ar gyfer cerbydau amaethyddol sy'n cyrchu tir oddi ar y ffordd honno, cerbydau yng ngwasanaeth yr awdurdod lleol yn unol â phwerau neu ddyletswyddau statudol a cherbydau brys:
- (i) Ffordd Di-Ddosbarth a adwaenir fel Lôn Fêl, Cricieth - O'i gyffordd gyda Ffordd yr A497 ger Bron Eifion Lodge, gan deithio mewn cyfeiriad cyffredinol gogleddol gan fynd heibio Parciau, hyd at ei gyffordd gyda'r Ffordd Dosbarth III a adwaenir fel Arfonnia, ger Cartref Nyrsio Bryn Awelon am gyfanswm hyd o oddeutu 435 metr sydd wedi ei liwio'n las ar y Map Gorchymyn.

Mae manylion llawn am y cynigion hyn yn y Gorchymyn ynghyd â chynllun yn dangos y ffordd yr effeithir arno a datganiad o resymau'r Cyngor dros argymhell gwneud y Gorchymyn ar gael yn (a) Swyddfeydd y Cyngor, Ffordd y Cob, Pwllheli (b) Llyfrgell Cyhoeddus Cricieth yn ystod oriau gwaith arferol. (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT FOR ACCESS - MONDAY TO
FRIDAY – 8.00 A.M. – 9.30 A.M. & 2.30 P.M. – 4.00 P.M.
LÔN FEL, CRICCIETH) ORDER 2024

On the 5th June, 2024 Cyngor Gwynedd made the above Order in exercise of the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other powers then enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order when it comes into force on the 1st July, 2024 will be to:-

- (a) Prohibit all motor vehicles from entering or proceeding on the sections of road noted below from 8.00 – 9.30 a.m. and 2.30 – 4.00 p.m. on Mondays – Fridays, except for access to properties on that road and for agricultural vehicles accessing land off that road, vehicles in the service of the local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and emergency vehicles:
- (i) The Unclassified Road known as Lôn Fel, Criccieth - From its junction with the A497 Road near Bron Eifion Lodge travelling in a general northerly direction passing Parciau up to its junction with the Class III Road known as Arfonia, near Bryn Awelon Nursing Home for a total length of approximately 435 metres which is coloured blue on the Order Map.

Full details are contained in the Order which, together with the map showing the length of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be examined at (a) Council Offices, Ffordd y Cob, Pwllheli (b) Public Library, Criccieth during normal business hours. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any regulations made under the act were not complied with in relation to the Order or any part of it may make application to the High Court for that purpose within six weeks of the date of publication of this notice.
