What is a micro care enterprise?

A micro care enterprise is an individual or small group of people (no more than 8) who work in their communities supporting people over the age of eighteen, who need support, to achieve what matters to them.

What does a micro care enterprise do?

The enterprises offer a range of services to people in their homes and community. They all have the same aim, to ensure people have the care or support that suits them to live full and safe lives in their communities.
